

Summer 2020 Camp Griffin Guidelines

The health and safety of our school community has and always will be our top priority. In response to COVID-19, the following guidelines/protocol are in place for Camp Griffin and must be followed by all students, faculty and families. As we continue to abide by recommendations issued by the CDC and DHEC, these guidelines are subject to change at any time.

Overview

Spartanburg Day School will offer Camp Griffin July 6 to August 7. To meet camp health and safety guidelines, camps will be open to currently enrolled Spartanburg Day School students only. Camp Griffin will be offered from 9a.m. to 4 p.m. with early drop off and late stay until options for an additional charge.

Drop Off:

- Campers must register prior to attending camp
- Parents/guardians will drop campers off at the Lower School carpool circle. Faculty members will walk campers into the building each morning. Parents will not have access to the buildings.
- Upon arrival, a faculty member will screen each child's temperature.
- Early drop off: 8 a.m.
- Camp drop off: 9 a.m.

Pick Up:

- Pick up: 4 p.m. in front of the Lower School Lobby or 100 wing.
- Late pick up: 5:30 p.m. in front of Lower School Lobby or the 100 wing.
- Camp faculty will walk campers to the pick-up area

Daily Expectations:

- Cloth face coverings are recommended but not required for campers 5 years and older.
- Cloth face coverings are recommended for faculty but not required.

- Campers will wash their hands upon entering the buildings and regularly throughout the day.
- Frequently used surfaces will be sanitized throughout the day.
- Lunch and snacks will not be offered and should be provided by each family.

Illness and Exposure

Families are asked not to send children to camp if they have a temperature of 99 degrees or if they feel ill or have been exposed to someone who is ill.

- If a child develops an illness while at camp, he or she will be removed from the larger group and cared for until a parent or guardian can pick up.
- Spartanburg Day School is not responsible for the potential exposure of and/or the subsequent illness of any participant or family member.

Neither Spartanburg Day School, its Board of Trustees, administration, or faculty imply that the policies or practices herein described shall prevent anyone who enters the campus for any reason from exposure to COVID-19. The polices, practices, and protocols in place for Camp Griffin are designed to meet federal and state guidelines as best practices to reduce exposure to COVID-19 and to outline the mitigating procedures that will be implemented in the event of an identified case of COVID-19 on the campus.
